Call Meeting to Order

- Meeting was called to order at 7:02 pm by Scott Meyer.

Minutes of Last Meeting

- Motion was made, seconded, and passed to approve the minutes from the D10 February meeting.

D10 Treasurer - Rhonda Madsen

- Beginning and ending balances were reported for February.
- All deposits have been made to date.
- Invoices will be completed and sent this week. Teams that do not advance, will be reimbursed their fee.
- Fees are due on Saturday during District tournament
- Motion to approve treasure report was made, seconded, and passed.

D10 President - Scott Meyer

- STANDINGS:
 - Bantam AA - Has one tie breaker, all figured out and submitted.
 - Bantam B1 - 3-way tie resolved
 - PeeWee AA - 2 games left to play. Final decision will be done Tuesday night. Blaine has chance to move up into the tournament if they win tomorrow night.
 - PeeWee A - Coon Rapids moved to 3rd place spot
PeeWee B1 - had 2 ties, resolved in head to head count.
 - 15A - 1 tie breaker, resolved with head to head Blaine/SLP is in 2nd place and Anoka/Rogers in 3rd.
 - 12A - had to use point percentage (Anoka/Rogers and Centennial) Anoka did get the spot ahead with fair play points.
 - 12B - had last place between Pine City and Andover, figured out to goal differential.
- Spectators at districts - we are staying with 2 spectators (and smaller siblings - under the age of 12) per player through districts. We are doing this to try to get through districts without getting shut down (Carver County is being shut down by the state)
- QR Code will be used to register as a spectator to attend games - Elk River and Princeton are using QR code for attendance at their rinks. Princeton said they have used it for some time and it is working very well.
- Strict mask policy will be enforced at all rinks hosting district games.
- Question: Do coaches get 2 spectators as well to attend games? Answer is yes, coach can have 2 spectators attend district games.

- League Coordinators need to check with their teams: If a team that is advancing to regions, but then ends up getting shut down due to Covid, will another team, if asked, be willing to step up and attend regions? League Coordinators need to get an answer prior to districts.
