D10 Supervisor of Officials - Robert Erickson

- Starting 12/1 went to 2 officials for all games, since we are low on officials
- First match penalty came in this weekend, so a hearing will be coming up for that to be addressed. (Bantam B2 at a tournament tin Mankato)
- Officials are struggling just a bit with Game Sheet, but they are moving forward and its getting better.

Game Schedule/Declarations - Tom Nergard

- Many thanks to D10, special thanks to Mike Mannin for all that he is doing for D10 and stepping in for Colleen.
- Rescheduling has been very minimal since adjustments were done before.
- Most weekends are blocked with games, so scrimmage requests are last to get assigned or approved at this point .
- We are at 88 refs currently
- There is a large January Tournament schedule, which the refs will do their best to cover.

Game Sheet - Jeff Zwerdling

- We have 477 games completed at this time.
- Coach or manager should always know who the starting goalie is, who is missing or who is suspended. If a player is suspending, and is marked as a viable player, he could have to sit out another game.
- If the Game Sheet is showing errors, the person should take exit, to move to the next step.
- If someone is greyed out on the team, Game Sheet does not recognize that person.
- 2 head coaches listed, will have to sign. Make sure you only have one head coach listed.
- Stats: each manager can print out a stat version of their teams' stats.
- In the score keeper space, we only ask for the First name and the phone number, so if there are questions, we can contact them for clarification.
- If there is a question about a score - the Head Coach should contact the League Coordinator, and then the League Coordinator should reach out to Jeff Z.

Items from the Floor

- Andover - feedback from their association, length of games for the PW B1 teams. For the presidents meeting next summer, can we look if 90 minutes is too long at this level.
- Ice time dedicated to the upper-level games/teams, with 90 minutes to 2 hour blocks - discussion point for this summer.
- Running D10 tournament over Spring Break, summer topic for the presidents to discuss over the summer.
- House Keeping - Ref rooms are for the refs ONLY - not for coaches or players getting dressed. Presidents, please make sure your rinks, rink managers, coaches and members are aware of this.
- Was there a rule change on the awards - if there is a 6 goal (or more) differential. Per Becky, there is no longer a goal differential in place, so an award can be given when the goals are higher than we have had in the past. Becky will ask if we can make a little stronger guideline when the score of a game is more than 10 goals. (The rule used to be more than 10 goals, no awards). We'd like to ensure we do not have teams running up the score.
- Feedback - Bantam B2, new penalties and 1 hour game, some 3rd periods are only 3-5-minute periods. There is a lot more whistles with offsides and icing during run time.
