Minutes of Last Meeting

D10 Treasurer - Colleen Donovan for Rhonda Madsen

- Handout on the table.
- Checking account balance was announced, after deposits and expenses.

D10 President - Scott Meyer

- Make sure background checks & safesport registrations are being completed.
 - District 10 Board members, Association Board members, & all volunteers in the district.
- Levels of play should be an honest assessment of the kids on the team.
- Review all association by laws & traveling team rules in preparation for upcoming season
- Send Head Coach information for each team and copy D10 Secretary Kelly Gribauval-Hite on the responses.
- Monitor inboxes for notices on player needs from other associations & get the word out if you have players looking for a place to play.
- If there are any potential issues that come up during the tryout process or team formations that may be escalated, give Scott a heads up.
- D10 Board members stay tuned for roster signoff assignments.

D10 Director - Colleen Donovan

- All Safe Sport Issues must be reported to Scott Grey, MNH sgrey@metrolegal.com
 - No association level suspensions until the association board has held a hearing
- D10 Handbook can be found on the website, 22-23 changes are found in red
- Game Sheets - D10 will cover the cost for the upcoming season, Associations will have to pay the cost (50%) starting 23-24 season, and the full cost the 24-25 season
- MN Hockey Girl's meeting 10/9/22, all team declarations must be in by 10/5/22 so state brackets can be out by end of November.
- MN Recreation league needs ice. If you have extra, contact MN Hockey.
- EMTs for Tria and Nova Care are booked. If you are hosting a tournament, starting looking for one.
- Waivers must be completed before a player is allowed on the ice.
- Reviewed coaching requirements for student coaches who are or will be turning 18 during the 22-23 season. Safesport and screening required.
- Not changing coach CEP registration requirements for roster signoffs.
- Going to see about a Level 4 class for D10 coaches only.

D10 Vice President - Jim Casey

D10 Mite Director - Dave Englund

- Prior to 12/3, all teams playing out of district will have to pay \$100 to have their rosters signed off. Schedule an alternate date with Becky Ewing.
- Mite Summit 10/29 at the Super Rink. Will send out schedule to Mite Directors within the week.
 - Will have CEP Levels 1-3
 - Will have classes blocked for D10
- Send Mite team numbers to Dave Englund by 10/17
- Mite A level league there are currently 11 A teams provisionally declared.
- If an association is moving up third graders, are sure to follow regulations.

D10 Registrar - Colleen Donovan for Becky Ewing

- Coaches with CEP expiring by 12/31 must have registered for a class and submitted proof (registration receipt) to association registrar prior to signoffs
- For issues with Safesport, best response is by email rather than calling. Send multiple emails for a faster response.
- Safesport can't be renewed until it has expired. Ex) Expires 9/4, cannot be completed until 9/5

D10 Hockey Director - Scott Meyer for Donn Berkeland

- Mite Summit will be on 10/29, schedule has been posted.
- USA Hockey is currently only posting clinics for two weeks in advance. Concerned that coaches may have difficulty meeting the requirement to have completed their CEP class or be registered for a CEP class prior to roster signoffs.
- All virtual Zoom clinics that Mike Orn has are currently full, two in person clinics are scheduled at the Blaine SuperRink in December with dates to be announced soon.
 - Wants to have private for D10 coaches prior to opening them up to the public.
- In person coaching clinics 11/6 Brooklyn Park, 11/7 & 11/10 in Blaine
- Virtual coaching clinics 9/19-9/20 & 10/11-10/12, these are 3-4 hours each day per class.

D10 District Tournament Coordinator - Colleen Donovan for Rick Wesp

- Hosting state tournaments for Jr. Gold A & B, 16U, Peewee A, 12UA, & 12UB
- Tier 1 prospects are the last team in tournament play. Game is in Colorado.
- Item from the floor would like to wrap up tournament play to avoid conflict with tryouts. Response - D10 does not force players to participate, family decision.

Game Schedule/Declarations - Tom Nergard

- Send teams to Tom ASAP for scheduling.
- Final team declarations by 10/8
- 10/27 official season schedule will be out, ten days before league play starts.
- Tryout scrimmages are covered on an as needed basis. If done 6 days or less before scheduled date, will be assessed a \$50 fine. Hard to find referees.
- Every Saturday through February is currently blocked from scrimmages. May open some dates once the regular season is scheduled.
- 203 teams in D10 this season
- Girls 10UB2 will not have a D10 league, will be sent to D2 or D3.

Game Sheet - Jeff Zwerdling

- Sent out email today to associations for gamesheets exhibition games if the teams are set. Prior to roster signoff teams will need to be manually entered with names and numbers.
- Names and logos have been added.
- Game Sheets training will be available on Zoom Mondays and Tuesdays for parents and managers to learn the program.
- Association Presidents should complete training also.
- Team codes for exhibition games will be out in mid-October.
- Reports will be sent to association Presidents for match or game misconducts.
