Minutes of Last Meeting

- Motion was made, seconded, and passed to approve the minutes from December Membership Meeting

D10 Treasurer - Rhonda Madsen not present provided handout on the table

- Checking account balance was announced, after deposits and expenses.

D10 President - Jim Casey for Scott Meyer

- Competition Committee has been looking at teams playing at levels beyond their capabilities. Associations need to evaluate teams better to determine where teams should be playing, not where parents think they should be playing.
- Association representatives brought concerns to the floor about needing additional time to evaluate teams after tryouts have been completed. No longer a two week window for final team declarations as in the past.

D10 Director - Colleen Donovan

- There are 5,319 waivers in D10, Rogers has the most waivers due to a school boundary change issue and Centennial has the most waived in.
- MN Hockey will be redistricting the state of Minnesota this year.

D10 Mite Director - Dave Englund

- Welcomed Dave Englund back
- Is keeping track of all team schedules, difficult to see on websites. A few associations have sent information, but have changed dates with last minute jamborees. There will be no more full ice games next year, only $\frac{3}{4}$ ice games

D10 Registrar - Colleen Donovan for Becky Ewing

- Coaches Pre-registration - only 7 were redlined vs 60 last year.
- Birth Certificates, when Mites register, they are given a 7 day window to get a birth certificate to Becky. If it is not done, an email will be sent that they will not be allowed on the ice.
- If coaches and players that are redlines are found to be on the ice, that association will be getting a fine. Presidents are responsible and must be responsible for the people under them.

- From Colleen Donovan - There have been five fighting penalties so far this season, one more from any of those players and they are done. The season runs until August. The player will not be able to participate in Tier 1, HP, etc. Presidents need to remind coaches to remind players

that fighting needs to stop. A player may run into a referee that calls a fighting penalty for the action, even though there is no actual fighting. Let's not lose any kids this season for fighting.
