  - Out of district incidents mean players sit for TWO games rather than one.
- Mite Full Ice and New Official Mentoring Program - went well. There were a couple of glitches.
- Has ideas and would like one President and one coach to meet in a small group to discuss how to make this program better for next year. One or two meetings only.
- State tournaments went well. D10 was complimented on what well run tournaments were put on.
